MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Lafargue asked Jackie Reviel, CEO of Allen Parish Hospital, to speak about the programs and services that are available at Allen Parish Hospital. She also talked about some recent remodeling to the hospital and the future plans for expansion.

Chief Paul Courville reported on the calls and activity for the month.

TOWN ATTORNEY REPORT

Mr. Holmes reminded the mayor and council that the annual Personal Financial Disclosure forms that are required by the Louisiana Ethics Administration are due May 15th.

ENGINEER REPORT

Wesley Miller reported on the public hearing held prior to the council meeting regarding citizen views for the FY 2020/2021 LCDBG application. He said there were a few recommendations from citizens, but they were not eligible under this grant and that the Town would probably apply for sewer rehabilitation for the Nixon Addition.

Mr. Miller reported that the pre-application to DEQ for funding to make necessary upgrades to the Town wastewater treatment facility has been sent off. He also reported that the Town has received a \$25,000 grant from the Louisiana Governmental Assistance Program (LGAP) that will be used to make repairs to the aerators at the wastewater treatment facility.

TOWN CLERK REPORT

Town Clerk, Traci Fontenot reported that income statements with monthly budget-to-actual comparisons are included in the mayor and council packets.
