TOWN ATTORNEY REPORT

Mike Busada, with Butler Snow, and DeDe Riggins, Municipal Advisor, were both at the meeting to explain insurance and surety options for the \$4,500,000 Sewer Refunding Bonds. They also asked council to consider adopting Resolution No. 2021-05 to amend a prior resolution adopted at the March 1, 2021 meeting regarding the issuance of the Sewer Refunding Bonds. After some discussion, a motion was made.
