TOWN ATTORNEY REPORT

Mike Holmes reported that he was still gathering information in regard to amending Ordinance No. 832, referred to as the “Golf Cart” ordinance, to include side-by-sides. He said the state revised its statutes regarding UTV’s since the Town’s ordinance was passed in 2014. He would like to have more time to research what other communities are doing and revisit this discussion at the December or January meeting. Some discussion followed.

TOWN ENGINEER REPORT

Wesley Miller reported that the repairs to the aerators at the Wastewater Treatment Plant are complete and should be installed this week. This project was funded by the 18/19 LGAP grant. He also reported that the Town has applied for a Capital Outlay Grant to help with the \$3.3 million Wastewater Treatment Plant Renovation Project.

TOWN CLERK REPORT

Town Clerk, Traci Fontenot reported that income statements with the monthly budget-to-actual comparisons are included in the mayor and council packets.
