Ordinance Reminder:

Sec. 14-52. - Required equipment for Golf Carts.

(1) Golf carts must be equipped with a rear vision mirror on the exterior of the driver's side, and a mirror on the passenger side or an interior mirror capable of providing the operator with a one hundred (100) feet clear rear sight picture and must be equipped with front and rear turn signals, head lights and brake lights.

(2) Slow moving vehicles must be equipped with the minimum motor vehicle equipment appropriate for vehicle safety as required in 49 C.F.R. 571.500.

Sec. 14-53. - Permit, application and revocation.

(a) All golf carts and slow-moving vehicles operated within the jurisdiction of the town must display, on the left side of the windshield a valid permit of operation sticker issued by the police department.
